
In this edition of our newsletter, you will find an overview of our progress, key initiatives, and highlights from the past quarter.




1000+ Applications for Frontliners

Frequently Asked Questions

FAQS

What is the role of the Transformation Management Office?

The Transformation Management Office (TMO) is tasked with delivering and providing recommendations for all transformation projects and programs to the Executive Committee and Board of Directors. While the TMO itself does not have decision-making authority, it plays a crucial role in guiding the transformation efforts. The TMO is overseen by Andrea Longhi, the Chief Transformation Officer, and the transformation is sponsored by the Board of Directors.

When will our new strategy launch?

It is expected to be launched in the first quarter of 2026. Our strategy will serve as a roadmap for academic excellence and global recognition. We are aligning our aspirations with our national vision and priorities, and integrating global best practices in higher . We are committed to shaping a distinctive path that prioritizes long-term interests and the success of KSU.

How will the transformation impact employment contracts, and which entity is responsible for workforce policies?

The University's Board of Directors and its Nominations and Remunerations Committee are responsible for defining workforce policies. Future workforce planning and contract structures will be determined based on the University's new strategic direction. We will communicate further details on this matter as they emerge.
