

It brought together students, faculty, and staff to co-create solutions across three key




tracks: Academic Experience, Campus Life, and University Operations—fostering collaboration and innovation to support KSU's strategic transformation.

# Transformation April 24-27, 2025 Hackathon A NEW KIND OF HACKATHON

#### What made this Hackathon different?

For the first time, faculty members, administrative staff, students, and alumni all joined forces — not just as participants, but as co-creators of KSU's future. The diversity of voices gave the Hackathon a unique flavor of collaboration and inclusivity, proving that transformation is everyone's responsibility.

What truly stood out were the stories of chemistry and connection across groups.

One of the winning teams, for example, brought together a faculty member and her daughter, a student — both working side by side on the same challenge. Another team featured a faculty member and his students, united in purpose and vision. In many cases, faculty, staff, and students sat together at one table, brainstorming and building solutions as one KSU family. This Hackathon didn't just generate ideas — it brought the university community closer together.

900+ participants competed across three-days

# Frequently Asked Questions FAQS

#### How will KSU faculty and staff be supported if their roles change or they are reassigned to new tasks?

All solutions presented during the Hackathon are currently under review. The TMO is assessing their feasibility for implementation in upcoming phases or for alignment with other planned or ongoing initiatives.

# Will academic programs or graduation requirements be restructured?

Academic programs are under comprehensive review to enhance integration and future relevance. Graduation requirements or academic programs may be updated accordingly, with all changes communicated well in advance to ensure readiness. These changes will be officially announced following the full approval of the university's strategic plan.

#### What is KSU's future posttransformation?

KSU aims to strengthen its global stature by unifying institutional efforts, committing to change, building strategic partnerships, and offering innovative academic programs and research opportunities that attract global talent. The transformation journey is rooted in agility and institutional resilience enabling the university to adapt proactively to global shifts.
