### Why these three?

This is the start of our journey! We chose these projects because they can be delivered with existing resources and create visible benefits. Longer-term priorities remain in the pipeline; however, this first phase focuses on small and impactful steps as the opening chapter of our transformation while we learn, iterate, and scale.

**Phase Two** 

Leading from the Front, Our Journey Continues

In parallel, we launched Phase Two at King Saud University Medical City, bringing the program into healthcare with remarkable engagement:

7,000+ patients and 1,600+ staff shared their voices through surveys helping us understand what matters most in their experience of care.

9 focus groups and 5 drop-in sessions across three hospitals captured honest reflections and hopes for the future

We are now carefully reviewing this input to shape the next steps at KSUMC, guided directly by your insights and experiences so we continue building a stronger, more patient-centered, and collaborative healthcare environment.
